Minutes of the review meeting with NABARD, Regional Rural Banks(RRB`s) and NHB for capital subsidy scheme for lighting & pumping implemented through NABARD under JNNSM on 25th April 2016.

The review meeting with NABARD, Regional Rural Banks(RRB`s) and NHB for capital subsidy scheme for lighting & pumping implemented through NABARD was held on 25th April 2016 under the co-chairmanship of Shri Tarun Kapoor, Joint Secretary, MNRE & Shri N.K. Bansal, CGM, NABARD. List of participants is at Annexure-I.

Shri Tarun Kapoor welcomed the participants and informed that the Ministry has been implementing lighting Scheme from the last five years and efforts are being done to bring pumping programme at the same level. He also informed that a continuation letter for Pumping Scheme for 2016-17 is already issued to NABARD.

CGM, NABARD informed that NABARD is aggressively working on this programme and there will be several state level/District level meeting will be held for reviewing & promotion of the scheme in next 3 months where all issues related to the scheme will be discussed.

After the detailed discussion Following Decisions were taken during the meeting:-

1. Capital Subsidy will be available upto 300Wp Lighting System only however bank can finance systems upto 1 KW but the subsidy will be limited to 300Wp only.
2. NHB will continue to implement the lighting scheme with National Housing Banks only with subsidy limited to 300Wp only.
3. Ministry has no objection in raising the advance parking of subsidy to banks from Rs. 50 lakhs to Rs. 1crore. NABARD will take the decision for raising the advance parking on the basis of performance of the bank.
4. NABARD agreed on exempting the Collateral clause for loans less than Rs 5 lakhs & to treat solar pumping system as an asset. NABARD will also write letter to all banks in this regard.
5. Banks are requested to use local unemployed youth for the maintenance of the system & may like to tie up with the manufacturers for providing the training to unemployed youth.

6. Ministry will update the list of empanelled manufacturers for lighting & solar pumping programme.
7. NABARD has informed that they are working on development of software and will get it developed for online application submission & tracking of the application for individuals/borrowers.
8. Test reports on complete system will be the criteria for lighting systems/pumps for eligibility of systems to be supplied.
9. A separate meeting with suppliers/manufacturers will be held to discuss the implementation issues & technical parameters of the systems.
10. Banks are requested to send complaints directly to ministry regarding suppliers/companies for not maintaining the systems at solarpumps.mnre@gov.in / tarun.singh@nic.in.
