Subject: Eligibility of Agencies Registered under Indian Trust Act 1882/Indian Trust (Amendment) Act 2015 and Sole Proprietorship firms for empanelment as Channel Partner.

The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) is implementing a "Grid Connected Rooftop and Small Solar Power Plants Programme" in the Country. The Government of India has set a target of 40,000 MWp of Grid-Interactive Rooftop Solar PV Plants by 2022. These rooftop solar PV plants will be set up in residential, commercial, industrial, institutional sectors in the country. Such rooftop plants have become economically viable. The Empanelled Channel Partners, Government Agencies and Channel Partner (New Entrepreneurs) play an important role in implementation of grid connected rooftop systems in residential, commercial, industrial and institutional sectors across the country.


2. At present the Agencies with one of the following registrations are eligible for empanelment as Channel Partner:

- Company registered under the company act 1956/2013 (CIN no.)
- Company registered with Central/State government authority (SIDC, DIC EM NO.) (Manufacturer/services)
- Incorporation of Limited Liability Partnerships (LLPs) under companies act 2013 (LLPIN)
- Partnership firm registered (under partnership Act.1932)
- SSI (Small Scale Industries)
- Reputed National Level NGO working in the field of renewable energy registered under society Act. 1860.

3. In addition to the above, the following agencies are eligible for Channel Partnership:

- Agencies registered under Indian Trust Act 1882/ Indian Trust (Amendment) Act 2015
- Sole Proprietorship Firms


4. For Agencies registered under Indian Trust Act 1882/ Indian Trust (Amendment) Act 2015, the scanned copy of registered Trust Deed may be



uploaded on SPIN under the head of Company Registration, while applying for Channel Partnership.

5. For Sole Proprietorship Firms, scanned copy of Aadhar Card of the proprietor along with any relevant registration certificate of the company may be uploaded on SPIN under the head of Company Registration, while applying for Channel Partnership. Also under one head of experience, a scanned copy of affidavit on non judicial stamp paper in support of nature of business conducted may be uploaded.

6. Other terms and conditions remain same as in notice no. 05/22/2013-14/RT dated 18.09.2015 and 09.05.2016.
