Subject: Submission of Reconciliation Reports for Commissioned Solar Power Projects where Concessional Customs Duty and Excise Duty Exemption are availed by Solar Power Developers/EPC Contractors – reg.

Ministry is issuing Concessional Custom Duty and Excise Duty Exemption Certificates to various Solar Power Developers towards installation of Solar Power Projects. As per affidavit submitted at the time Total Bill of Material approval, it is mandatory on part of Developers/EPC Contractors that reconciliation certificates for the projects indicating usage of EDEC/CCDC certificates along with relevant documents have to be submitted within 60 days from commissioning of Project.

2. Ministry has made a provision in the program available under the head Utilization Report at <http://164.100.194.45/CCMS> so that the reconciliation certificates can be generated from the system by the Developer for the sanctioned Projects. This information shall be shared with custom and excise department.

3. All the Developers/ EPC Contractors are required to submit the Reconciliation Certificates verified by chartered engineers for all the commissioned projects failing which approval of subsequent BoM and issuance of EDEC and CCDC certificates may be withheld in future and Developers/EPC Contractors shall be liable for inordinate delay, if any.
