

3. India had expressed its willingness to comply with the ruling for which India would require a Reasonable Period of Time (RPT). After negotiation with United States, the RPT was given upto 14th December 2017. This RPT was negotiated on the basis all ongoing DCR projects for which PPAs are already signed and projects are under installation will be completed by 31st December.


