## Office Memorandum

Subject: Solar Wind Hybrid projects- proportioning Renewable Purchase obligation - reg.

On 14 May 2018, MNRE issued the "National Wind-Solar Hybrid Policy", which provides that power procured from the hybrid project may be used for fulfilment of solar RPO and non-solar RPO in the proportion of rated capacity of solar and wind power in the hybrid plant respectively.

- 2. It is hereby clarified that the RPO contribution of Obligated Entities (OE) consuming energy from hybrid wind-solar power plant shall be based on the relative proportion of energy contributed by each source, calculated based on the ratio of declared capacities of each source in the PPA. However, if during implementation, the actual installed capacity of each source is different from that declared in the PPA, then the OE would have the option to choose the proportion of each source based on actual ratios of capacities installed of each source, and not the capacity indicated in the PPA.
- 3. This issues with the approval of Hon'ble Minister (I/C) Power & NRE.
