
Subject: Matter related to Type Certificates issued as per GL Guideline for the
Certification of Wind Turbines, Edition 2003 with supplement 2004 –Reg.

The GL Guideline for the Certification of Wind Turbines, Edition 2003 with supplement 2004 has been reported expired w.e.f 30 June 2017. The matter related to treatment of Type Certificate for wind turbine generator (WTG) models issued under these Guidelines having validity beyond 30 June 2017 was examined and it has been decided that such WTG models will remain in the RLMM list up to the date of validity of Type Certificate or 30 June 2018 whichever is earlier, subject to fulfilment of all other conditions as required under new RLMM procedure.

2. Beyond 30 June 2018, the manufacturers of such WTG models should obtain the revised Type Certificates as per the prevailing IEC/GL certification scheme. If the manufacturers fails to submit the revised Type Certificates on or before 30 June 2018 the WTG models will be removed from the RLMM list without prior intimation to the WTG manufacturers.

3. No proposal for inclusion of WTG models in RLMM will be entertained, if the Type Certificate is issued as per GL Guidelines for the certification of wind Turbines, Edition 2003 with supplement 2004 after 30 June 2017.
