OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The Ministry of New & Renewable Energy had notified National Off-Shore Wind Policy in October 2015 to realize the offshore wind power potential in the country. Preliminary studies has indicated good wind potential for off-shore wind power both in southern tip of Indian peninsula and west coast.

Considering that, the off-shore wind quality is better than on-shore wind and keeping in mind our national commitments towards climate change goals, the targets of off-shore wind power installation capacity are fixed as 5 GW by 2022 and 30 GW by 2030.
