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**Subject:** Recruitment of Nine (09) posts of Scientist 'B' (Group 'A' Gazetted) in the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE)

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Applications are invited from Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE)-2018 qualified candidates for filling up of Nine (09) posts of Scientist 'B' (Group 'A' Gazetted) in the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), on direct recruitment basis. The brief details of the posts are as under:

### 1. DETAILS OF THE POST AND MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

#### 1.1. Essential Qualifications and GATE Subject with Code

1.2. Only those candidates who have scored following minimum marks in GATE, 2018 are eligible to apply:

#### 1.3. Age limit

Not exceeding 35 years, which is relaxable upto 5 years for Government servants and candidates belonging to SC/ST categories and 3 years for candidates belonging to OBC(NCL) category. In case of persons with disabilities, age relaxation of further 10 years is admissible in addition to age relaxation admissible to candidates of SC/ST/OBC(NCL) category.

#### Note:

- The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be closing date for receipt of application and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and

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Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Union Territories of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep.

- ii. Candidates seeking reservation as SC/ST/OBC, will have to submit at the time of interview, caste certificate, indicating clearly the candidate's caste, the Act/Order under which the caste is recognized as SC/ST/OBC and the Village/Town the candidate is ordinarily resident of, **ONLY** in the prescribed proforma meant for appointment to posts under the Government of India from the designated authority. PwD Certificate should also be as per the format as prescribed for employment under Central Government. If the certificate has been issued in a language other than English/Hindi, the candidates will be required to submit a self-certified translated copy of the same either in English or Hindi.
- iii. OBC candidates must ensure that they possess the latest Non-Creamy layer certificate issued by Competent Authority for Government of India posts and in terms of Department of Personnel and Training's Office Memorandum No. 36033/2/2018-Estt.(Res.) dated 08.06.2018. A certificate containing any variation in the caste name will not be accepted.
- iv. OBC claim of a candidate will be determined in relation to the State (or part of the State) to which his/her father originally belongs. A candidate who has migrated from one state to another state should, therefore, produce an OBC Certificate which should have been issued to him/her based on his/her father's OBC Certificate from the State to which he (father) originally belongs.
- v. No change in the community status already indicated by a candidate in his/her application form for this exercise will ordinarily be allowed.
- vi. Further, OBC candidates must submit a declaration in the format enclosed at Annexure II, in addition to the certificate issued by the Competent Authority.

## 2. SELECTION PROCESS:

The selection process will comprise of the following:

- a) **GATE – 2018:** The desirous and eligible candidates having the essential qualification for the advertised posts should have appeared in Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) 2018 as indicated in Para 1.1 above and declared qualified by the GATE-2018 authorities.
- b) The **GATE - 2018 Marks** in the subject mentioned against the posts will be considered by MNRE for shortlisting the candidates for the further selection process of Personal Interview as per the criteria decided by MNRE.
- c) The final merit list shall be prepared based on the weightages assigned to various parameters as follows:

- d) In order to be selected, candidates are required to qualify in the GATE-2018 and thereafter again in the interview separately in addition to fulfilling qualification criteria. To qualify in the Interview, General candidates are required to score minimum 30 marks out of 50, OBC candidates are required to score minimum 25 marks out of 50 & SC/ST/PwD candidates are required to score a minimum of 20 marks out of 50 marks in Interview.
- e) In case the total marks (weightage of GATE Marks + Interview) for final selection are same then candidate with higher GATE Score will be considered and if GATE Scores are same, then the one older in age will be considered for selection.



- f) Only **GATE-2018** Score is valid for the recruitment exercise in MNRE under this advertisement. Score from GATE-2017 or from any previous GATE examination is not valid.

3. **HOW TO APPLY**


- (a) Applications should be neatly typed on thick plain paper (A-4 size 210 x 297 mm) only in the prescribed format given below at Annexure-I.
- (b) Candidates working in Government Departments/ Public Sector Undertakings/ Autonomous Organisations should apply through proper channel. Such applications will be considered only if received through proper channel with NOC of the competent authority of parent Department/ Organisation of the candidates within the prescribed last date of receiving applications. Such applications if received after the last date shall not be considered even if an advance copy has been received from the candidate before the last date or the competent authority of parent Department/ organisation has approved/ signed/ forwarded the applications before the last date but the same is received in MNREW after the last date. Hence it is the responsibility of such candidate to follow up their application in their department/ organization and insure that their application, duly forwarded by their competent authority are received by MNRE within the prescribed time limit. **NO RELAXATION SHALL BE GIVEN IN THIS REGARD.**
- (c) A copy of GATE 2018 Admit Card and Scorecard alongwith copies of certificates in support of highest educational qualifications, date of birth, Disability, Community (in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates only) and experience should be attached with the application with self-attestation. **Candidates will have to produce the original certificates at the time of Interview.**
- (d) Applications received after the closing date or received incomplete in any respect are liable to be summarily rejected. MNRE shall not be responsible for any delay on the part of postal department for delivery of application even if posted before the last date. No representation against such rejection will be entertained.
- (e) Completed applications in all respects including photocopies of relevant documents/certificates should be sent to **Under Secretary (Administration), Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Block No. 14, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi – 110 003**, by Registered Post or through Speed Post in a cover superscribed "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF SCIENTIST 'B'" **within a period of 30 days of date of publication of this Circular in Employment News** and within 45 days for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep). In case the last date is Saturday/Sunday or closed holiday then the day prior to that will be treated as last date of receipt of application. Candidates are also advised not to send applications by ordinary posts or through courier. Candidates desiring to deliver their applications by hand can do so only by delivering the application to any of the following authorized officer, by obtaining a duly signed receipt bearing date of receipt. No claim shall be entertained in the absence of such a receipt from duly authorized officer:
- i. Section Officer, C.R. Section, MNRE, Or
  - ii. Authorized Staff of C.R., Section, MNRE.

4. **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- (a) All applicants must fulfill the essential requirements of the post and other conditions stipulated in the advertisement. They are advised to satisfy themselves before applying. No enquiry asking for advice as to eligibility will be entertained.
- (b) Screening and selection will be based on the details provided by the candidate; hence it is necessary that applicants should furnish only accurate, full and correct information. Furnishing of wrong / false information will be a disqualification and MNRE will **NOT** be responsible for any consequence of furnishing of such wrong/false information.

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- (c) Candidature of the registered candidate is liable to be rejected at any stage of recruitment process or after recruitment or joining if any information provided by the candidate is found false or is not found in conformity with eligibility criteria mentioned in the advertisement.
- (d) Court of Jurisdiction for any dispute will be New Delhi.
- (e) The admission at all the stages of selection process will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. Mere issue of interview call letter to the candidate will not imply that his/her candidature has been finally cleared by MNRE. MNRE takes up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to original documents only after the candidate has been shortlisted for Interview.
- (f) The selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in India.
- (g) Canvassing in any form or influencing the officials related to the selection / recruitment process would result in immediate disqualification of the candidate. In case of any dispute, the decision of the management of MNRE will be final and binding on all candidates.
